During her painting travels Lenartowicz doesn't get attached to one tool, form or style, although she admits that RecyclingArt is particularly close to her heart. When creating, she often uses old materials found in attics, grandma's cupboards, or worn-out books.

By adding old prints, vellum, or common packaging paper, she gives new life to bits of everyday stories, and allows spectators to contemplate and interpret the paintings from a different perspective.
